JEE ADVANCED 2021

With the much awaited JEE Advanced results declared on 15th October 2021, Ashoka Universal School and Junior College along with Champions Academy is proud to announce that 6 of its students have qualified JEE Advanced.

Master Goraksh Kolge achieved an All India Rank of 779 in advanced and had scored 99.86%ile in Mains. 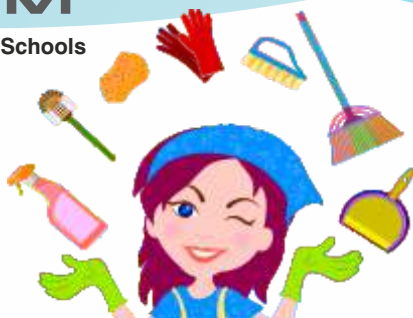
WHAT MATTERS IS ON THE INSIDE

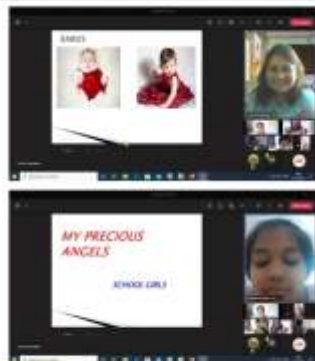

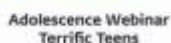
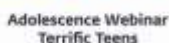

We are indeed thankful to the esteemed facilitator Dr. Abuzar Indorewala, DNB (ENT).

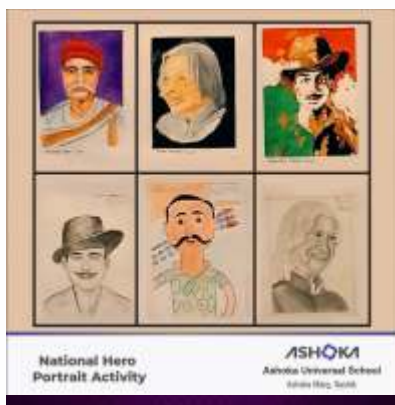

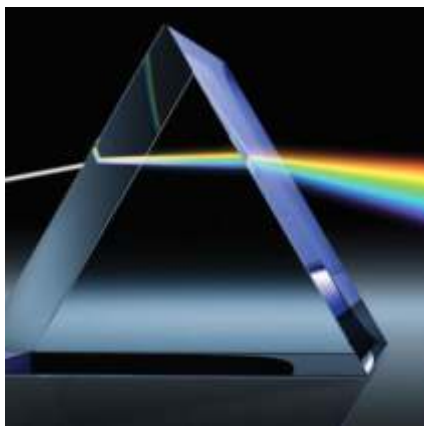

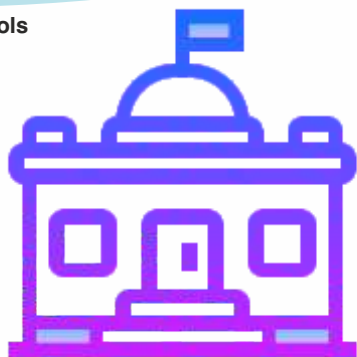
The students, acting as members of Parliament from various states presented their views on steps to be taken on the bill under consideration.
